Its superb cuisine, fine wines and hospitable people make this a tourist paradise of the highest quality.

Portugal is situated at the south-west point of Europe. Mainland Portugal occupies an area of 88,889 square km. It is 218 km wide and 561 km long. It has 832 km of Atlantic coast and a 1,215 km border with Spain with a population of about 10 million. The population density is at its greatest in Lisbon, the capital and its suburbs, where about 1.9 million people live. The second largest city in Portugal is Oporto in the north.

The climate in Portugal varies considerably from one region to another and is influenced by the relief, latitude and proximity to the sea, which offers mild winters, especially in the Algarve.


In the Porto e Norte area and Beiras region, particularly inland, nearer Spain, the winters are colder, although the temperatures are still mild when compared to the rest of Europe. There is some snowfall; it occurs mostly in the Serra da Estrela mountains, where we find the highest point in mainland Portugal (1,991 m) and where it is sometimes possible to ski.

The summers are hot and dry, especially in the inland areas (Trás-os-Montes in north-eastern Portugal and Alentejo). Typically there are often warm, sunny days in autumn making this destination ideal all year around. Come and discover the charms of this country.

DAY 1 • LISBON

Arrival at Lisbon airport. Meet and greet, transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight.

DAY 2 · LISBON

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Belém district to see the monuments that pay tribute to the Portuguese golden era of the Discoveries: Belém Tower (glimpse), Monument to the Discoveries (glimpse), Monastery of Jerónimos (visit to the church). Visit to the National Coaches Museum, containing one of the most important and richest collections of coaches in the world. We will then immerse into the old Lisbon, Alfama, characterized by its white houses, labyrinthine streets, inner courtyards and dead ends. Return to the hotel. Afternoon at leisure. Overnight in Lisbon.

DAY 3 • LISBON/SINTRA/CASCAIS/ESTORIL/LISBON

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure from the hotel towards Sintra, a magnificent UNESCO World Heritage site. Discover the charms and history of the town that enchanted kings and poets. Visit to the romantic National Pena Palace. If weather permits, we will then stop at the westernmost point of mainland Europe, Cabo da Roca. On the way to Cascais along the coast, be dazzled by the seascape. In Estoril, place where Ian Fleming got the idea for the James Bond character, we highlight the gardens of one of the largest Casinos in Europe. Return to the hotel. Overnight in Lisbon.

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Transfer to Lisbon airport. END OF OUR SERVICES.

DAY 1 • PORTO

Arrival at Porto airport. Meet and greet, transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight.

DAY 2 · PORTO

Breakfast at the hotel. The city of Porto is rich in well-preserved treasures, as the Cathedral, the Tower of Clérigos and the area of Ribeira (UNESCO world heritage site). Despite a stark preservation of ancient monuments, Porto also stands out for having ultra-modern buildings, much admired by international architects: Casa da Música, Serralves Foundation, among many others. Visit to a Wine Cellar of Port with a superb view over the old Ribeira (wine tasting). Afternoon at leisure. Overnight in Porto.

DAY 3 • PORTO/DOURO VALLEY/PORTO

Breakfast at the hotel. We set to the phenomenal Douro region, the first demarcated wine region of the World (1756) and where the famous Port Wine is produced. The tour will take you to Lamego to visit the sanctuary of Nossa Senhora dos Remédios and to Pinhão to take a 50-minutes cruise on the Douro river. Return to the hotel. Overnight in Porto.

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Transfer to Porto airport. END OF OUR SERVICES.

4 DAYS • 3 NIGHTS

DAY 1 • LISBON/ÉVORA

Leaving Lisbon, through a beautiful and bucolic landscape of olive trees, cork oak trees and vineyards, we arrive to Évora World Heritage of UNESCO. Walking tour on its narrow streets of this whitewashed town, to visit some of its most important monuments: the Roman Temple, the Romanesque-gothic Cathedral, Saint Francis Church with the "Bones Chapel", and the University. We'll also discover the local market and the diversity of local handicraft with cork, ceramic and copper objects. Afternoon free at leisure to explore the city. Overnight in Évora

DAY 2 • ÉVORA/BEJA/SILVES/LAGOS

Breakfast in hotel. Departure to the south region, passing by Beja, with the highest tower of Portuguese Medieval castles. Crossing small mountains, we enter the Algarve region. By fields of orange trees we arrive to Silves, with its red sandstone Castle, dating back to Moorish times. Continue to the golden sand beaches of the Algarve passing by Praia da Rocha. Arrival to Lagos, overnight.

DAY 3 • LAGOS/PONTA DA PIEDADE/SAGRES/CABO S.VICENTE/LAGOS/ALVOR

Breakfast at the hotel. We begin by visiting Ponta da Piedade to admire the magnificent view over the Atlantic Ocean. Then, continuing to the fishing port of Sagres , to visit the fortress and the mythical "navigation school" related to Prince Henry the Navigator, during the Portuguese Discoveries. Along the cliffs, we arrive to Cabo S. Vicente, the most southwestern point in Europe. The journey end at the city of Lagos, a cosmopolitan and fishing port, where you can taste the most delicious Fish and Shellfish courses, and the fine regional sweets, such as the famous marzipans, almond and fig cakes. Return to the hotel and overnight.

DAY 4 • LAGOS/SETUBAL/SERRA ARRABIDA/LISBOA

One last look at the crystal clear water, while traveling along the coast, we make our return to Lisbon. On the way we'll visit the city of Setúbal, a major port and industrial centre, on the north bank of the Sado estuary. Then we'll be swept by the views of the Tróia Peninsula and the scenic route over the Arrábida Mountain range Natural park, with its unique vegetation. After crossing the bridge over the Tejo river, we arrive to Lisbon. End of the services.

DAY 1 • FUNCHAL

Arrival at Funchal airport and private transfer with private driver to the hotel. Overnight in Funchal.

DAY 2 • FUNCHAL/CÂMARA DE LOBOS/ CURRAL DAS FREIRAS/FUNCHAL

Breakfast at the hotel. Leaving Funchal towards the west, you will discover the small fishing town of Câmara de Lobos and the Cap Girão, the highest bluff in Europe and the second highest in the world with 580 meters. The former English first minister, Winston Churchill, painted this exceptional portrait when he visited the island in 1950. It is in this commune that the singular parish of Curral das Freiras is located. Situated in a deep valley, Curral das Freiras offers one of the most impressive landscapes of the island, attracting the admiration of all visitors with its breathtaking panoramas (over 500 meters above sea level at the Eira do Serrado viewpoint). Return to Funchal. Afternoon at leisure. Overnight in Funchal.

DAY 3 • FUNCHAL/CALHETA/SÃO VICENTE/ FUNCHAL

Breakfast at the hotel. Take the direction of the sunny coasts of Ponta do Sol and Calheta, very rich in bathing areas that invite you to swim. You can also visit the Casa das Mudas Arts Center, which offers an extensive cultural program through-out the year. The beaches of the picturesque villages of Jardim and Paul do Mar offer sports lovers excellent surfing. Then head in the direction of Porto Moniz and regain

strength, during an invigorating bath in the famous natural swimming pools dug into the rock. The journey continues in the direction of São Vicente, on a road dotted with waterfalls and where the contrast between the majestic green and the crystalline blue of the waters of the sea is obvious. Here you can visit the caves and the center of Volcanism, the exhibition center - Lime Road or simply walk through the narrow streets of this charming little town. Return to Funchal. Overnight in Funchal.

DAY 4 • FUNCHAL/SANTANA/FUNCHAL

Breakfast at the hotel. Head towards the town of Santana, declared Reserve of the Biosphere in 2011 by UNESCO. This reserve incorporates a terrestrial element, corresponding to the whole surface of the municipality, but also a marine element, which presents a great diversity of natural, human, landscape, environmental and cultural values of local, regional, national and international interest. The municipality was for a very long time inaccessible by sea and by land, its inhabitants have preserved characteristics that have not undergone external influences. One of the examples of this isolation is the architectural style of its typical houses with thatched roof more commonly known as "Santana's small houses". Return to Funchal. Overnight in Funchal.

DAY 5 • FUNCHAL

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Private transfer to the Funchal airport. END OF OUR SERVICES



DAY 1 • LISBON/QUELUZ

Arrival at Lisbon airport and pick-up of the rental car. Drive to Queluz. Overnight in Queluz.

DAY 2 • QUELUZ/SINTRA/ESTORIL/QUELUZ

Breakfast at the hotel. Set off to the magnificent UNESCO World Heritage town of Sintra. Discover its charms and history, exploring the historic center, and taste the local sweet delicacies: travesseiros and queijadas. Then, drive to the westernmost point of mainland Europe, Cabo da Roca. On the way to Cascais along the coast, appreciate the seascape. In Estoril, place where Ian Fleming got the idea for the character of James Bond, we highlight the gardens of the largest Casino in Europe. Overnight in Queluz.

DAY 3 • QUELUZ/ÉVORA/ESTREMOZ/CASTELO DE VIDE/MARVÃO

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Drive to Évora, standing in the middle of the beautiful plains of the Alentejo. This walled city was declared World Heritage by UNESCO. We highlight the Roman Temple and the curious Chapel of Bones. In the afternoon, visit Estremoz, a town dominated by its Medieval Castle. Then, Castelo de Vide and its winding streets with old white houses. Climb a few meters in altitude to reach the walled city of Marvão, at the top of São Mamede Mountain. Overnight in Marvão.

DAY 4 • MARVÃO/TOMAR/COIMBRA/VISEU

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Trip to Tomar, city of the Templar Knights, with its Convent of Christ, a city ex-libris. Continue to Coimbra, the city of students, so called to host one of the first universities in Europe and the most important of the country. Stroll in the oldest part of Coimbra, made of narrow streets that lead to the top of the hill. Departure to Viseu, an ancient city, built of grey stone but at the same time green, lively and welcoming, Overnight in Viseu.

DAY 5 • VISEU/LAMEGO/PESO DA RÉGUA/ AMARANTE/AMARES

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Departure to Lamego, an episcopal city known by the Baroque Sanctuary of Nossa Senhora dos Milagres. To the

north, located on the banks of the Douro River, Peso da Régua played an important role in the production and marketing of Port Wine, since it was from this city that the wine barrels were transported by special boats equipped with a long rudder to Vila Nova de Gaia, where the wine was aging in the cellars. Departure to the charming town of Amarante, stands on both sides of the Tâmega River. Overnight in Amares.

DAY 6 • AMARES/BRAGA/VIANA DO CASTELO/ **PONTE DE LIMA/AMARES**

Breakfast at the hotel. Direction Braga, one of the oldest Christian cities in the world with a vast religious heritage, as are the sanctuaries that make up the triangle of faith: the Cathedral and the Sanctuaries of Bom Jesus and Sameiro. Continue to Viana do Castelo, a seaside town at the mouth of the Lima River, famous for its craftsmanship and the colours of its regional costumes. Above, overlooking the city, stands the shrine of Santa Luzia. Before heading back to the hotel, drive to Ponte de Lima, sitting in the region, where is produced the famous vinho verde (green wine). Overnight in Amares.

DAY 7 • AMARES/GUIMARÃES/PORTO

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Set off to Guimarães, considered as the cradle of Portugal, because the birthplace of Alphonse Henriques who would became the first king of Portugal. Associated with the formation and the identity of Portugal, the historical center of Guimarães located within the enclosure of the walls was classified world inheritance by UNESCO. Departure to Porto, capital and gateway to the northern region, Porto is an ancient city that gave its name to Portugal and wine known around the world: the Port wine. With a magnificent location near the mouth of the Douro River and an architectonic ensemble of exceptional value, the historic center of Porto has been a World Heritage Site since 1996. Overnight in Porto

DAY 8 - PORTO

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Rental car drop off at Porto airport. END OF OUR SERVICES.

DAY 2 · LISBON

Breakfast at the Hotel. Departure towards Sintra for a luxury day. Visit the Palace of Sintra and walk through this charming village. Enjoy the amazing view from the western most point of Europe (Cabo da Roca). Stop for lunch (included). Along the coast we pass by one of the most famous surfing beaches, the incredible Boca do Inferno, the cosmopolitan Cascais and the gardens of Estoril casino. Return to Lisbon (overnight).

DAY 3 • LISBOA/ÓBIDOS/ALCOBAÇA/NAZARÉ/ BATALHA/FÁTIMA

Bum dia! Your escort will be happy to meet you and you will journey onward. By a landscape rich in windmills and fruit trees we arrive to Óbidos, surrounded by medieval walls, where we can admire the harmony of the architecture, the diversity of the handicrafts, and taste the famous 'ginginha' (bitter cherry liqueur). Visit Alcobaça with the first and largest gothic church in Portugal, where lies the tombs of D.Pedro and Inês de Castro, known by its love story. Stopping in Nazaré, a typical fishing village and seaside resort, with its traditions and legends. We continue to Batalha to visit the Monastery of Santa Maria de Victoria church, a masterpiece of the gothic in Portugal where we can find the tomb of Henry the Navigator, promoter of the maritime discoveries. Afterwards, we arrive to Fátima , the famous Marian Shrine. Possibility to assist the Candle procession. Fátima - overnight.

DAY 4 • FÁTIMA/COIMBRA/AVEIRO/PORTO

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure towards Coimbra – visit of the University, one of the oldest in the world, with its magnificent baroque library and its unique atmosphere characterised by ancient traditions and customs, such as the students black capes and the melancholic 'fado' music. Stop at St Clara Church, where lies the tomb of the beloved Queen St. Isabel, the protagonist of the "Roses Miracle". In the city centre you can admire the exclusive ceramic of Coimbra. In the afternoon we continue to Aveiro, city of the canals, known as the "Portuguese Venice", where you shall have time to admire the graceful boats "moliceiros" sailing across the river, and taste the local egg sweets "ovos moles". Porto - overnight.

DAY 5 • PORTO/GUIMARÃES/BRAGA/PORTO

Breakfast at the hotel. Porto, the 2nd city of Portugal and world heritage by UNESCO - a living amphitheatre, inviting us to make a morning visit to discover the riverside area, old houses, palaces, and churches, that history has made eternal, and also the Port wine, known worldwide. We

continue to "Minho", the northwest region of Portugal that offers natural green sceneries and the sparkling "green wine". Starting by Guimarães - the cradle of the nation, birthplace of the first king of Portugal. Walking along its historic centre, for moments, one is plunged back into medieval times. Visit of the Sacred Hill, crowned by the Castle, as well the Palace of the Bragança Dukes, which original building dates back to the 15th centuries. Drive to Braga, known as the "Portuguese Rome" for its concentration of religious architecture, such as the oldest Cathedral of the country, and the "Bom Jesus do Monte" Sanctuary with famous baroque stairway and gardens. Return to Porto. Overnight.

DAY 6 • PORTO

Breakfast at the hotel. Free day at leisure to enjoy the city. Today discover: Santiago de Compostela, the capital of Galicia and the centre of pilgrimage at the end of the Santiago Way. In 1985, UNESCO declared Santiago de Compostela World Cultural Heritage and you have the entire day to freely discover this fascinating city. Wander in its historical streets and learn about its most extraordinary monuments before tasting some of the traditional local dishes. Porto — overnight.

DAY 7 • PORTO/AMARANTE/VILA REAL/DOURO VALLEY/LAMEGO/URGEIRIÇA



Located along the Douro River, this city had a preponderant role in the production and marketing of Port Wine, since it was from here that the wine barrels were transported in rabelos boats to Vila Nova de Gaia, where the wine aged in the cellars. Then we will visit a winery to visit the wineries and wine tasting. Return to Porto. Overnight in Porto. (B)

DAY 4 • PORTO/AVEIRO/COIMBRA/FÁTIMA


