## DAY 1 • ROME/ASSISI/SIENA/FLORENCE

Departing at 7:15 am from Rome downtown specified meeting point (TBD) at the time of booking by a deluxe coach, you will arrive in Assisi, ready to explore, at your own leisure, this tiny town surrounded by walls, built in the Middle Ages. Take your time to visit the basilica of St. Francis, where you will see masterpieces by Giotto and Cimabue and, then, have free time for lunch (not included). Board on the bus to reach Siena, a Unesco World Heritage Site, world-known for the Palio, the historical horse

race around the shell-shaped town square: Piazza del Campo. Next, you will continue on to Florence, where you will check in at your hotel before enjoying dinner and a well earned night of rest. **(D)**

## DAY 2 • FLORENCE

Florence After breakfast, you will spend the day venturing around beautiful Florence, the “Cradle of Renaissance”, where, with the help of Michelangelo, Italian art reached its pinnacle. Based on Etruscan-Roman origins, the city flourished in the Middle Ages as a free “Comune” and was further refined during the Renaissance. You will be fascinated by the uncountable monuments, churches and buildings as Santa Maria del Fiore, more commonly referred to as the Duomo. On your visit, you will be amazed by its magnificent dome built by Filippo Brunelleschi. Cross a small piazza to see the “Campanile” tower (partly designed by Giotto) and the Baptistry, with its bronze doors where Michelangelo imagined the “Gates of Paradise.” In the heart of the city, you will see Piazza della Signoria, Palazzo della Signoria (also known as Palazzo Vecchio), and the Basilica of Santa Croce. Lunch in a typical Tuscan restaurant in Piazza Santa Croce. Spend the afternoon strolling the cobblestone streets of Florence on your own or take a short trip to Pisa (optional), one of the four main historical Maritime Republics of Italy. There, you will tour the Piazza dei Miracoli with the Duomo, Pisa’s symbol “the Leaning Tower” and the Baptistry. Dinner at leisure, overnight stay in Florence. **(B/L)**

**DAY 3 • FLORENCE/BOLOGNA/PADUA/  
VENICE**

After breakfast in Florence, departure to Bologna. There, you will discover the elegant city center with its "porticos", its shopping streets and so on.

From Piazza Malpighi you will walk to Piazza del Nettuno and Piazza Maggiore (Neptune square and Major square) in the heart of the city, then King Renzo's Palace; Palazzo Podestà and the basilica of San Petronio, one of the biggest in the world. Bologna it's a real gourmet's heaven... don't miss a tasty meal at your own leisure! In the afternoon, continue toward Padova, with Sant'Antonio Basilica: one of the most visited churches by pilgrims of the catholic world. Later in the afternoon, arrival in Venice\*. Check in at your hotel for dinner and overnight stay. **(B/D)**

## DAY 4 • VENICE

After breakfast, enjoy your private transfer to Piazza San Marco, with “Skip the Line” tickets to visit the splendid St. Mark’s Basilica and, after this, check out the most iconic places of the “Floating City”: the Palazzo dei Dogi, symbol of Venice’s glorious past, the legendary “Bridge of Sighs”. Spend the afternoon roaming along Venice’s canals at your leisure, and **Private Gondola Ride INCLUDED** and then return to the hotel and overnight. **(B)**

**DAY 5 • VENICE/TUSCANY WINE REGION  
(MONTEPULCIANO)/ROME**

After breakfast, departure from Piazzale Roma heading to Tuscany, world-known for its landscapes, its churches and castles and its delicious wines. You will proceed to Val di Chiana with a stop in Montepulciano, a medieval town rich in history and art. Known for its "Nobile" wine, on purchase in local wine houses, Montepulciano also hosts an annual Jazz and Wine Festival every July. Lunch in a typical restaurant included!!!! After lunch, quick stop to spend some free time. In the evening, you will arrive in Rome, where you will be transferred to your Rome Hotel, and overnight. **(B/L)**

## DAY 6 • ROME

Breakfast at the hotel, then at approximately 9:00 a.m. get ready for a wonderful morning enjoying a 3 hour "Discovering Rome" with your guide walking through some of the most famous and iconic sites to Rome. The tour will begin Largo Argentina and continue on to Piazza Navona, the Pantheon and the Trevi Fountain. The tour will end at the Spanish steps where you can enjoy as much shopping time as desired and enjoy lunch with a view of the monuments (not included). Rest of the day at leisure and overnight. Dinner not included. **(B)**

## DAY 7 • ROME/NAPLES/POMPEII/SORRENTO

Today you will depart the ancient city, to venture off into the amazing Amalfi Coast. Breakfast and pick-up between 7:00-7:45 a.m. from your hotel, you will journey in the comfort of the high-speed train with reserved seating to Naples. Once arrived in Napoli, together with our local expert you will proceed to Pompeii for the guided tour of the archaeological excavations. This ancient Roman city was destroyed when Vesuvius erupted in 79 AD and buried it, preserving it under a sea of volcanic ash for nearly 1700 years. At the end of the visit transfer to Sorrento, famous for its picturesque old town centre and characteristic fisherman's village of Marina Grande, one of the most authentic treasures of the city. A local assistant welcomes you at hotel during the check-in. Dinner and overnight stay.

## DAY 8 • SORRENTO/CAPRI/SORRENTO

Breakfast in the hotel and departure at 7:30 a.m. for the port of Sorrento. Meet the guide and sail to Capri by hydrofoil. After arriving at the island, enjoy a boat trip around the island and have the possibility to visit the **Blue Grotto Entrance**

**INCLUDED!** Continue by minibus to Anacapri. Then reach the legendary Piazzetta, heart of the island. Return to the port to head back to Sorrento. Dinner and overnight stay. **(B/D)**

**DAY 9 • SORRENTO/AMALFI/POSITANO/  
RAVELLO/SORRENTO**

Pick-up from the Hotel and transfer by minibus for the world famous Amalfi Drive. English speaking assistant available on-board. First stop will be Positano. Thanks to its unique architecture, the town is considered today one of the most beautiful stretches of our coastline (1 hour of free time). Continuing through the wonderful villages of Praiano, Furore and Conca dei Marini, we'll stop in Amalfi for 2 hours. Free time at your disposal to discover the history of this ancient Maritime Republic. Last stop will be Ravello. 1 hour of free time to stroll around this little village located just above Amalfi. Return to your hotel for dinner & overnight. **(B/D)**

**DAY 10 • SORRENTO/NAPLES/ROME**

Breakfast at hotel and day of leisure to explore Sorrento perhaps last-minute shopping, or last swim. At approximately 3:00 pm meet at the hotel lobby and transfer to the meeting point with other participants where you will meet our local assistant at Naples train station to board the high speed train(1st Class Reserved Seats) returning to Rome. Arrival in Rome between 7:00 - 9:00pm and drop off at the Hotel. Overnight in Rome. **(B)**

## DAY 11 • ROME

Buongiorno! Enjoy your last breakfast with us in Rome, at the hotel. End of our services. **(B)**
